### Section 331: Elimination of Block Claim Edit Checks

- Modifies requirements for edit checks and follow-up reviews related to detection of block claims in CACFP.
- Implementation memo CACFP 03-2011 December 17, 2010

### Section 122: Nationwide Expansion of At-Risk Afterschool Meals in CACFP

- Extends eligibility for at-risk afterschool meal reimbursement to all States
- All institutions participating in the at-risk afterschool care component of CACFP are eligible to claim reimbursement at the free rate for up to one snack and one meal served to each eligible participant per day.
- At-risk afterschool meals and snacks must be served free of charge and are reimbursed at the applicable free rates.

### Section 121: Area Eligibility for Family Day Care Homes

- Modifies the requirements for using area eligibility data to make tiering determinations for family day care homes participating in CACFP

### Section 334: Administrative Payments to Family Day Care Home Sponsoring Organizations

- Modifies the requirements for administrative payments to sponsors of family day care homes (FDCH)

### Section 331(a): Permanent Agreements in CACFP

- Modifies requirements for permanent agreements in CACFP
- require permanent operating agreements between the State agency and institutions participating in CACFP
- Implementation memo CACFP 07-2011 issued January 14, 2011

### Section 102: Foster Children

- Foster Children are categorically eligible for free meals.
- Foster children may also be counted as part of the family.

- Interim rule published April 25, 2011

#### Section 301: Privacy Protection

- Only requires the last four digits of the signing adult's Social Security Number
- Removes collection of SSN for verification
- Implementation memo CACFP 09-2011 issued February 15, 2011

#### Section 305: Cooperation with Program Research and Evaluation of Child Nutrition Programs

- State agencies, local educational agencies, schools, institutions, facilities, and contractors participating in the Child Nutrition Programs are required to cooperate with the Department of Agriculture officials and contractors conducting evaluations and research.

- Final rule issued June 29, 2011

#### Section 333: Transmission of Household Income Information by Tier II Family Day Care Homes in CACFP

- Modifies requirements for the transmission of household income information by tier II family day care home providers in CACFP

#### Section 334: Carry Over of Unused CACFP Administrative Payments

- Modifies the basis for making administrative payments to family day care home (FDCH) sponsoring organizations (sponsors) in the Child and Adult Care Food Program
- Implementation memo CACFP 18-2011 issued April 8, 2011

#### Section 331(b): Child and Adult Care Food Program Applications

- Modifies the requirements for the periodic submission of renewal applications by institutions participating in CACFP
- Implementation memo CACFP 19-2011 issued April 8, 2011

#### Section 221: Potable Water

- Make free potable water available to children for consumption in the place where meals are served during meal service
- Implementation Memo CACFP 20-2011 issued April 12, 2011,

#### Section 221: Fluid Milk

- Modifies requirements for fluid milk and fluid milk substitutions in the
- Offer a variety of fluid milk consistent with the Dietary Guidelines
- Serve only fat-free (unflavored or flavored) and unflavored low-fat milk
